KOROGOCHO-based music program Ghetto Classics is set to collaborate with a famous German classical quartet, Salut Salon (pictured).

The famed quartet was founded by violinist Angelika Bachmann and Iris Siegfried in 2002. They will be in the country for a few days, where they will collabo with the slum-based youth unit and stage two performances in Nairobi on Thursday and Friday at MJ Centre and Villa Rosa Kempinski [HOTEL](#)  respectively.

The partnership will see the experienced group share their knowledge with the 300 children who are part of the programme.

Started in the year 2009, the Ghetto Classics programme is a community project that involves music education and provides the youth with opportunities to enhance their lives and strengthen their community.

This is done by instilling in them the life skills that come with the discipline of studying art music, and by providing them with income generating opportunities.
